- Crayons

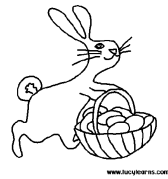

We are Havin' a Hunt!

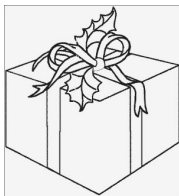
